1 Notification of changes to classes of flying operations

1.1 Purpose

There is currently no documented process to formally notify aircraft and support units of unscheduled changes to the class of flying operations at YBOK. Currently notification relies on emails and minutes from meetings held in previous weeks.

2.1 Procedures

In lieu of AND-4, paragraphs 5.2 and 5.3 of Oakey AD2 Supplement, the following procedure shall be used:

ARFF, MED, ECC and CRH are to report their 'on line' status to the AOC 15 minutes prior to the commencement of planned flying operations. If contact can't be made with AOC then ATC shall be notified. In the event that one of the 'support services' becomes aware that they can not remain on line, have planned to be 'off line' during the scheduled period of flying operations or have become 'on-line' they are to notify AOC by phone as soon as practicable. AOC shall then notify ATC by phone of the change in class of flying operations.

Aircraft will be advised by ATC directed transmission immediately when the class of operations reduces. Increases in class of operations will be advised by ATC as soon as practical but no later than the next OPS Normal. Restricted and Limited Operations will be promulgated on the ATIS.

The AOC will notify all flying units and appropriate support agencies by pager system or email when any change of the class of flying operations occurs.

Paragraph AD-4, paragraph 5.4 is renamed 5.3.

3.1 Expiry

This amendment is effective until cancelled, or incorporated into AD2 SUPP OAK.
