Aeronautical Information Bulletin (AIB) 001/2026

Issue date: 22 May 26

### 1. AIB Dissemination

1.1 The AIB may at times contain information that is **critical to flight safety**. Unit PUBSOs are required to disseminate the AIB as widely as possible to relevant staff at their unit particularly aircrew, safety/standards teams, and unit execs.

### 2. Air Services Australia En-Route Supplement Australia (ERSA) Re-Release

2.1 Air Services Australia have re-released ERSA Complete book for the 2607 AIRAC cycle, due to multiple errors in formatting. The updated version of ERSA will be effective 09 Jul 26. Further information can be found [here](#).

### 3. Withdrawal of Charts from TERMA

3.1 With effect from 2607 TERMA, current **composite and divert** charts will be removed as they have been deemed no longer required by users.

3.2 YWLM STEREO charts will remain in TERMA due to military specific routing from restricted airspace surrounding YWLM. This will be in effect until the creation and publication of the appropriate STARs to replace them.

### 4. En-Route Supplement International (ERSI) Content Reduction

4.1 AIS-AF will reduce ERSI facilities content for all aerodromes to technical movement area data only (e.g runway data). ERSI is a resource-intensive publication due to the compilation and validation of non-essential facilities data that is widely available through numerous open-source EFB applications. This broadly aligns with the information currently published in the TAG section of ERSI. These changes will take effect in the 2609 AIRAC cycle (WEF 03 Sep 26).

### 5. Aeronautical Information (AI) Distribution Issues

5.1 Due to the recent Defence transition to Australia Post, it was necessary for some existing base postal addresses, including PO Boxes or Locked Bags, to change in order to enable mail deliveries on Defence bases. Unfortunately, in some cases this has resulted in a delay for receipting required AI. This is beyond AIS-AF Distribution's control and is currently being addressed with our Distribution supplier DPTS.

### 6. International Products

## 6.1 Butterworth International Terminal Procedures (WMKB ITP)

6.1.1 WMKB ITP dated 17 Apr 25 remains valid WEF 17 Apr 25. The only change has been the addition of Para 4 on Page 2 as follows:

- a. When a displaced threshold is promulgated by NOTAM, straight-in approaches are authorised to circling minima only.

6.1.2 The Butterworth IFG (produced by the RMAF) is reviewed each calendar month, with updates to the ITP normally promulgated outside the AIRAC cycle. Due to differences in cyclical production with EFB Data Service Providers and Aircraft Nav databases, **AIS-AF strongly recommends all users check the AIS-AF web-portal to determine if there is an updated product and refer to AUS HO NOTAMs for critical amendment advice.**

6.2 Papua New Guinea MSA/VSA Chart dated WEF 19 Mar 26 remains valid

It remains the user's responsibility to ensure they are using current versions and to be aware of any amendments. Current FIHA AD2 Supplements and any Next/Amendments may be viewed at any time on the AIS-AF web-portal.
